Section 1100.60 Court Appearances

Male Employees

Male employees, appearing in court, who are not required to appear in uniform, should wear a dress shirt, tie and either a sport coat or a suit, unless otherwise approved by the Chief of Police.

Fashion should be modest and conservative in fashion

Female Employees

Female employees, appearing in court, who are not required to appear in uniform, should wear a dress, pantsuit, sweater or sport coat and slacks, unless otherwise approved by the Chief of Police. Fashion should be modest and conservative in fashion.

Employees assigned to the Metro Narcotics Unit are exempt from the above dress code requirements.

Exceptions to Wearing the Uniform

Employees are exempt from the wearing of the established uniform in the following capacities or situations:

- Criminal Investigation Division (C.I.D.) personnel when performing plain clothes Assignments.
- Any officer with the approval of a commanding officer.
- When in official attendance of a meeting, special event, training session or any other on duty event that would not require uniform or special considerations of civilian attire.
